COURSE ESSENTIALS

FLEXIBLE DELIVERY

The programme is designed to facilitate participants working full or part-time. It is delivered via blended learning with weekly face-to-face instruction (usually a half day on Tuesdays) complemented by different forms of interactive technologies.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The programme takes two academic years. Participants complete modules leading to 60 ECTS in Year 1 and a further 30 ECTS in Year 2.

MODULES & ASSESSMENT



ASSESSMENT

In Year 1, all modules involve continuous assessment and participants start an e-portfolio to work towards 60 ECTS.

In Year 2, you participants complete an applied e-learning project under the guidance of a supervisor (30 ECTS).

APPLICATION & FEES

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants will normally hold a 2.2 honours degree or equivalent. Graduates of DIT's Postgraduate Diploma in Third Level Learning and Teaching (or equivalent) can enter the programme with exemptions. External applicants may also be eligible for exemptions through evidence of professional practice.

FEES

A fee waiver applies for DIT Staff. For applicants external to DIT, the annual fee is €2,835.
